First, we transformed a portion of formal dining room into a cozy den with a hidden door tucked behind the kitchen. Now, it's the perfect retreat or guest bedroom.

The original layout had awkward arches and poorly placed doorways. We removed the arches to open up sightlines, creating a more cohesive space.

We transformed a spare bedroom into a bright laundry room/mudroom, giving the couple a more organized and welcoming private entry.


Relocating the primary bedroom entrance from the living room to a back hallway improved furniture placement, added wall space for art, and expanded the living area by three feet.




With the couple's art collection in mind, we created intentional spaces, like well-lit feature walls and open sightlines, to showcase their treasured pieces.


























