
### Edmonton Design Week



The backyard boasted a beautiful pool, but since it was out of sight from inside the house, it posed a safety concern. To address this, we added windows that offer a clear view of the pool area, allowing parents to easily keep an eye on their kids while inside the house.



Our approach was all about enhancing the home's best features, like those vaulted ceilings, and bringing in as much natural light as possible. We installed large windows in the family room to showcase the beautiful field of poppies in the backyard and added a mudroom for better functionality. This mudroom provides easy access from the garage and front door, as well as garden doors leading to the backyard from the master bedroom.

The renovation prioritizes creating a home that feels like a personal sanctuary. With thoughtful design choices that blend indoor and outdoor living, it offers a retreat-like atmosphere where you can entertain guests or unwind with family. This space is crafted to feel like your own private escape, where comfort and connection come together beautifully.








- **Zoned Spaces:** The design creates distinct zones while maintaining a cohesive flow between areas.

- Enhanced Natural Light: New windows have been added to allow natural light to pour in from all sides, brightening the entire space.




































